Sustaining the quality existed at the time of NAAC accreditation through proper maintenance and improving the standards of the institution strength which has increased from 1037 to 1145 there are other development aspects.

The college was started with the objective of upliftment of rural girls from poverty and ignorance through higher education for which various curricular and co-curricular programmes are available.

Certificate courses in Spoken English, Fashion Designing, Kinder Garden Teacher Training and Pot Painting, Glass Painting & Fabric Painting were conducted and certificates were given participants. 18. Community services:

During the academic year 2006-2007 to create “Chikungunya awareness” among the public, the students of the college formed Human Chain at Vandavasi Town on 11.07.2006. Books and uniform were donated to a physically challenged school boy on 11.10.2006. Special camps were conducted by the NSS in the nearby villages. Blood and urine analysis, chikungunya and dengue awareness, personal hygiene for healthy living, importance of herbs in curing diseases, diet for diabetes and heart diseases, village cleaning, competitions for women and children, AIDS awareness programmes were conducted by the two units of NSS existing in the college.

The Youth Red Cross, Human Rights Club and National Service Scheme conducted AIDS awareness programme on 10.12.2006. Cultural programmes on AIDS awareness and documentary films were played.

Inter collegiate quiz and poster competitions on the topic – Healthy Youth for Healthy India – were conducted and prizes were distributed to the winners on 17.12.2006(Human Rights Day).

On the international women’ s Day(08.03.2007) a blood donation camp was organized on behalf of NSS, LEO Club and YRC and 50 students and staff donated blood. Student were tested for Hemoglobin count.

Ms.P.Jansi, II year B.Sc., Computer Science(NSS Volunteer) was nominated for pre Republic Day camp in 2007. MS.K.Anitha, I Year B.Com., (NSS Volunteer) has been nominated for an NSS Programme to be held at New Delhi between 06.05.2007 and 12.05.2007.

Two NSS volunteers participated in a two day NSS Programme on Entrepreneurship Development and Career Development; Environment Awareness Programmes Conducted by the Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore on 29.03.2007 and 30.03.2007.

Computer and internet facilities are available in the institution.

29. Financial aid to students:

604 students are availing community based scholarship worth Rs.8, 54,051/-. Three candidates have applied for Indira Gandhi Scholarship. 41 students have applied for Farmer's Scholarship worth Rs.95, 000/-. One student received National Merit Scholarship.

30. Support from the Alumni Association and its activities:

The funds raised through OSA(Old Student Association) was Rs.27,795/- The Ninth Convocation was conducted and 381 graduates and post graduates were awarded degrees. From the academic year 2006-2007 a special trophy for the best outgoing student has been instituted. 12 economically backward students are provided with noon meal packets. The OSA has proposed to award an individual trophy for each department for best outgoing student: best teacher awarded and to provide free uniform and study materials for poor students.

Parent – Teachers Association has been formed with five parents as office bearers and three teachers as representatives.
